Follow the rules to complete the grid

Each row must contain the numbers 0 to 9, with no repeats  
(numbers can be repeated in columns).

The numbers in the columns must add up to the number at the  
bottom of each column.

The numbers in connecting cells (even diagonally connecting cells)  
must be different.
